



Average number of pupils in classes taught




How much autonomy do you have in your work?




At work, are you informed in advance about important decisions?




Is your work recognised / valued by the school administration and/or superiors?




How do you currently rate the quality of your relationship with the following stakeholders?




Do you feel safe at your workplace?

Level of discipline of pupils






Have you been the victim of workplace violence in the past 12 months?


Who were the perpetrators of the violence?*












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Satisfaction: amenities (electricity, drinking water...)




Satisfaction: sound level outside the buildings






Satisfaction: air quality outside the buildings







Provides regular help/support to a family member or friend




Usual travel time from home to work






To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statements?



If I had to do it again, I would choose my profession again




I have the impression that my profession is valued by society










Worked while sick (last 12 months)




If yes, for what reason(s)?

















Frequency of use of digital tools in the context of professional activity




Frequency of use of personal digital equipment for professional activities








The use of digital technology in my work is supported by the administration





Digital tools have enabled me to improve my relationships with students/families












Do you know your rights regarding occupational health?



To what extent are these persons concerned about staff health and well-being?




Frequency of occupational medical appointments



Do you have access to training and/or prevention resources on health/well-being?





VI. Formal comparison of ECE staff with primary education staff

In the present section, ECE staff (students' age: 3-5 years old) are formally compared with their primary education counterparts (students' age: 6-11 years old) on a range of key variables, from sociodemographic/professionnal characteristics to indicators of professional well-being or general health.

In practice, a selection of dichotomous indicators has been defined and each was compared between the two groups, territory by territory, using a chi 2 test.

The result of the statistical test reads as follows: NS= non-significant, * p-value ≤ 0.05 , ** p-value ≤ 0.01 and *** p-value ≤ 0.001

Caution: group sizes are quite different (see in the introduction), as are the percentage values compared
