Call for participation

On the sidelines of the **10th World Congress of Education International** from July 29 to August 2, which will bring together its **383 member organizations worldwide**, representing over 32 million teachers and education staff, the [Education and Solidarity Network \(ESN\)](#) will celebrate its 15th anniversary during the [Global meeting](#) “Tackling challenges and sharing solutions for the health and well-being of education staff”. This meeting is organised with the support of Education International and the [UNESCO Chair “Global Health and Education” \(GHE\)](#) and will take place in **Sheraton, Buenos Aires, Argentina** on **July 27th** from 2 pm to 6 pm ART.

This anniversary will provide to ESN an opportunity to discuss the results of the [2023 International Barometer of Health and Well-being of Education Staff \(I-BEST\)](#) survey during a [Solutions forum](#). The Solutions forum take shape of workshops addressing **key themes** emerging from the results of the 2023 I-BEST.

Members and partners of the Education and Solidarity Network are invited to participate to the **“I-BEST Poster Awards”** submitting a poster and sharing their initiatives on improving the **health and well-being of educational staff**. We’ve provided a poster template, but you can let your creativity run wild!

As part of the Solutions forum, this poster exhibition will be one of the highlights of the ESN General Assembly in Buenos Aires **promoting good practices** for improving the health and well-being of education staff.

- **I-BEST topics:**

- Occupational medicine and social protection
- Physical and mental health
- Professional experience
- Health conditions, information, and support
- Working conditions and environment
- Organisation and school administration
- Social relations at work
- Violence in school

- **Categories:**

I-BEST Award: The highest score on total points.

Innovation Award: The highest score on Originality and Innovation.

Change-Maker Award: The highest score on Potential Contribution and Impact.

Each prize will be rewarded with support funding worth **€1000**, except for the I-BEST Award which is worth **€1500**.

- Submission deadline: July 9 by **5 pm**
- Selection: An initial selection will be made by ESN and the UNESCO Chair GHE committee, which will evaluate all the proposals received.
- Submission to votes: on July 27

- **Evaluation criteria:**

Freestyle visual: The visual aspects of the poster, including layout, hierarchy of information, and overall style, will be evaluated. Use your creativity!	/3
Relevance of the initiative: The proposal should showcase its relevance in enhancing the health and well-being of educational staff by explicitly connecting a concern highlighted by the I-BEST results to the theme of the initiative. All good practices or promising initiatives are welcomed!	/5
Originality and Innovation: Proposed initiatives should demonstrate creativity and introduce valuable advancements within the realm of educational health and well-being.	/6
Impact, Feasibility and Replicability:	/6

<p>Initiatives supported by empirical evidence and showcasing their effectiveness and credibility.</p> <p>Evaluation will assess the expected significance of the contribution on educational staff and the overall school environment.</p> <p>Proposals must be feasible and adaptable for implementation in similar contexts. The potential for replicating the initiative in other establishments or regions will also be considered.</p>

- **Submission and selection procedure**

Please send the poster in PPT format, by e-mail no later than July 9, 2024, to the following address: secretariat@educationsolidarite.org

An initial selection will be made by a jury made up of members of the ESN and the UNESCO GHE Chair, who will evaluate all the proposals received. A notification of acceptance, request for clarification, modification or refusal will be sent to each author.

The selected posters will then be exhibited online on ESN's website starting the 3rd week of July and physically during the I-BEST Solutions forum on July 27 in Buenos Aires¹.

¹ Selected authors will de facto authorize the organizers to distribute their poster, notably via ESN and UNESCO GHE's website.
